

ASHBOROUGH POOL INFORMATION AND RULES

WELCOME

Welcome to the Ashborough Pool. Please review the pool rules with your family in order to make the pool as safe as possible. By utilizing the pool facilities, you agree to abide by the rules. The new pool combination lock code will be effective May 1, 2010.

POOL MAINTENANCE AND ATTENDANTS

All of the pool attendants are trained in first aid and CPR for the professional rescuer and life-guarding. In addition, most of the attendants are either high school or college swimmers on different teams in the area.

U.S. Aquatics will provide daily maintenance of the pool area this year. U.S. Aquatics is a certified pool operating company that maintains several pools in this area. If at any time you see a problem with the pool or facilities please let the pool attendant know and a pool committee member will take care of the issue.

SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK

Swim at your own risk allows swimmers access to the pool without the presence of an attendant. However, with this privilege comes responsibility. Solo swimming is not allowed.

No minor (under the age of 18) is allowed to swim at your own risk unless accompanied by a parent/legal guardian.

First Offense: If a minor is found to be at the pool during swim at your own risk by a member of the Pool Committee or Ashborough Board without a parent/legal guardian their parent or legal guardian will be contacted and the incident documented.

Second Offense: If a minor is found to be at the pool during swim at your own risk by a member of the Pool Committee or Ashborough Board without a parent/legal guardian the minor will lose their swimming privileges for the season.

Swim at your own risk hours are 5:00 am – 11:00 pm each day of the week except for the following exceptions:

- Swim Meets
- Emergency pool closing

POOL CLOSED

The pool is closed each night at 11:00 pm and will re-open at 5:00 am the next morning. If anyone is found in the pool during the pool closed hours Dorchester County Sheriffs office will be contacted.

SWIM LANE

A designated swim lane is always provided for those wanting to swim laps during open swimming and Ashborough Alligator swim practice. Please be considerate of the person swimming laps and keep children and floats out of the designated swim lane.

POOL MEMBERSHIP AND GUESTS

Membership:

- Families that live in Ashborough must pay association dues of \$335 to attend the pool.
- Families that live in one of the Ashborough condominium communities must purchase a pool membership for \$250 to attend the pool.
- Families that live outside of Ashborough can purchase a pool membership for \$250 to attend the pool.

Guest:

Six guests are allowed per family membership at one time. **Guests** are considered to live outside of Ashborough and both Ashborough condominium communities.

POOL RENTAL OPTIONS

Three options are available to rent the pool:

Option 1 Rent the Pool Deck (private party - pool closed) Cost \$150 plus \$160 returnable deposit if the pool area is left in a clean and satisfactory condition. This option is only available Saturday nights from 8pm – 10 pm May through September, excluding Holiday weekends. Pool attendant to be hired by party at a rate of \$15/hour per 25 guests.

Option 2 Rent the Civic Building and Pool (pool open to all residents) Cost \$60 plus \$160 returnable deposit if the pool and civic building areas are left in a clean and satisfactory condition. (the pool is not closed to Ashborough residents during a party). Pool attendant to be hired by party if the guest count is over 6 at a rate of \$15/hour per 25 guests.

Option 3 Rent the Picnic Shelter and Pool (pool open to all residents) Cost \$25 (the pool is not closed to Ashborough residents during a party). Pool attendant to be hired by party if the guest count is over 6 at a rate of \$15/hour per 25 guests.

GRIEVANCES

Pool attendants have complete control of the pool. If you have a complaint about an attendant that is not life threatening, it must be handled through proper channels. A grievance form can be obtained from the pool during attendant hours or from a pool committee member. You must fill it out as completely as possible and mail it to Ashborough Civic Association, Attn: Don, Mantooth, Pool Committee Chairman, P.O. Box 50043, Summerville, SC 29485. The pool committee staff will address the problem in a professional manner. Complaining directly to the attendant distracts him/her from doing their job and takes away the authority that we have given him/her to keep our children safe.

The Ashborough pool is the home of the Ashborough Alligators Swim Team. The pool closes at 5:00 pm on the evenings when a home swim meet is hosted and 3:00 July 12 for the Chene Moore Invitational Meet. Please to come to the meets and cheer on the Alligators! Practice times for ages 7 and up team:
 May – 4:00 pm – 7:30
 June through July 16th 7:00 am – 11:00 am.

The 6 and under group will be practicing at 11:30 in a portion of the pool; however the pool will not be closed.

The pool is closed during swim team practice for open swimming. **One swim lane will be open for lap swimmers during swim team practice.**

POOL RULES

Rules are posted at the pool. **Pool Attendants have complete control of pool discipline at all times.**

1. THERE SHOULD BE NO SOLO SWIMMING.
2. THERE SHOULD BE NO RUNNING, BOISTEROUS OR ROUGH PLAY.
3. NO PERSON UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL OR DRUGS SHOULD USE THE POOL
4. THERE SHOULD BE NO SPITTING OR BLOWING NOSE IN POOL.
5. PERSONS WITH DIARRHEA ILLNESS OR NAUSEA SHOULD NOT ENTER THE POOL.
6. PERSONS WITH SKIN, EYE, EAR OR RESPIRATORY INFECTIONS SHOULD NOT ENTER THE POOL.
7. PERSONS WITH OPEN LESIONS OR WOUNDS SHOULD NOT ENTER THE POOL.
8. NO ANIMALS OR PETS ALLOWED IN THE POOL.
9. NO GLASS ALLOWED IN THE POOL OR ON THE DECK.
10. NO CHILDREN SHOULD BE IN THE POOL WITHOUT SUPERVISION.
11. YOU SHOULD TAKE A SHOWER BEFORE ENTERING THE POOL
12. THE POOL IS OPEN FROM 5:00 AM TO 11:00 PM.
13. THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF SWIMMERS ALLOWED IN THE POOL IS 75.
14. A FIRST AID KIT IS LOCATED IN THE GUARD ROOM.
15. AN EMERGENCY PHONE IS LOCATED IN THE GUARD ROOM AND OUTSIDE THE GUARD ROOM. (messages will not be passed via the pool phone)
16. A SAFETY DEVICE IS LOCATED ON THE WALL BEHIND THE GUARD CHAIR BETWEEN THE MEN AND WOMENS RESTROOMS.
17. THE LICENSED POOL OPERATOR AT THIS FACILITY IS U.S. AQUATICS.
18. NO SMOKING WITHIN THE FENCED POOL AREA.
19. CHILDREN 9 OR UNDER MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY SOMEONE 14 OR OLDER DURING THE PRESENCE OF A POOL ATTENDANT.
20. CHILDREN 10 AND OLDER MAY ATTEND THE POOL IN THE PRESENCE OF A POOL ATTENDANT.

Please go over the rules of behavior with your family. If the attendant needs to discipline your child, they will use the following procedure.

First warning—Your child will be asked to sit out for 15 minutes.

Second warning---Your child will be asked to leave the pool.

Third warning----One week loss of pool privileges.

Fourth warning---Loss of pool privileges unless with a parent.

Fifth warning---Loss of pool privileges

Please Note: The Pool Committee reserves the right to change or add pool guidelines or rules at any time.
